NOTICE ABOUT WATERCRAFT ON BEACH

At the 2011 Annual Meeting of the Laurel Beach Association, the Police Committee proposed, and the membership voted to require the registration of all watercraft left on the beach from May 15th through October 31st to identify the owner in the event of need for removal, damage or loss. Prior to and subsequent to these dates, all watercraft should be removed from the beach.

A small watercraft is defined as a row boat, kayak or small sailboat.

Watercraft owners need to be aware of forecasted storms and strong winds/tides and are responsible for removing their watercraft in advance of threatening weather in order to protect the property owners along the beach as well as protec ng their watercraft. Watercraft are required to be removed 48 hours prior to pending storms. Any watercraft not removed within the required time frame will be removed from the beach at the owner's expense. A fee will be assessed if LBA removes the watercraft in the event of weather.

Registration stickers will be sent out to affix to the watercraft upon receipt of the completed registration form on the reverse side of this notice. If you already have a sticker on your craft that is in good condition and with legible information, you do not need to get a new sticker each year but we do ask you to complete the form for each season.
